



COVENANT LEARNING MODEL

Parent and teachers covenant together to play active roles in the educational process to ensure consistency of life and learning at school, at home, and at church, in order to effectively create life-long disciples of Jesus Christ who possess the faith, wisdom, and character necessary to fulfill God's will for their lives.

Characteristics:

- 3 “days of “direct instruction” at school (*Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays*); 2 days of “guided instruction” at home. (*Mondays, Fridays*)
- “Direct Instruction” Day courses:
 - Bible, English Language Arts, Math, Science, Social Studies, handwriting, cursive
- Enrichments offered on “Direct Instruction” days: Physical Education, Music, Art, looking into the possibility of additional enrichments
- Blended (Multi-age) classes
 - Blending will be determined by which students/grades enroll, by the needs of the students, and will ensure achievement of grade-level requirements.
- “Guided Instruction” day expectations:
 - Parents will not typically be expected to introduce new material
 - Administer tests/quizzes
 - Access to online media for educational videos, etc.
 - *There will be an in-service to help guide parents on “home” day expectations*
- Field Trips will be offered.

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
