John 15:5, 8

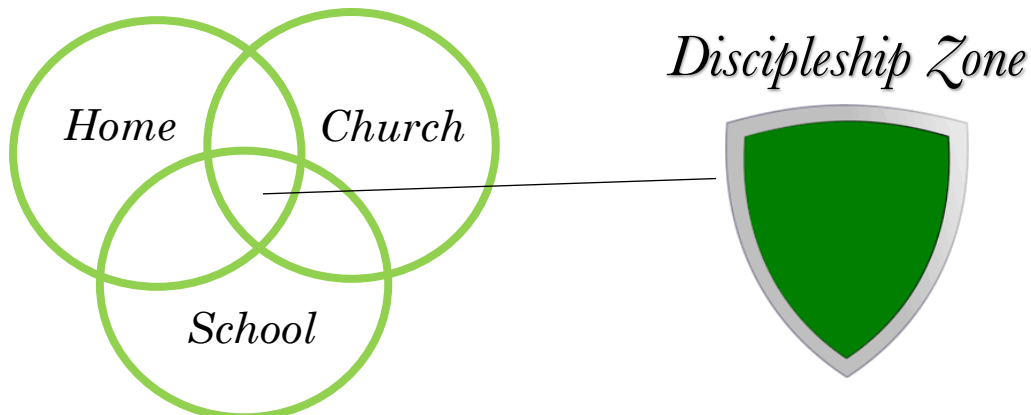
Christian discipleship is not separate from an academic education, but rather gives purpose to it.

How Do We Equip Our Students?

1. Build FAITH

- *Foundation of Love (Galatians 5:6 – Faith works by love.)*
- *Christian Parent Partnership*
 - **Key to effective discipleship: *Consistency of Life and Learning at school, home, and church.***



2. Build WISDOM

- *In the World* – able to know about and relate to this world
- *Not of the World* – Using knowledge for God’s glory
 - Minds renewed with God’s Truth (Romans 12:1, 2)
 - Hearts filled with God’s Desires (Ps. 37:4)
 - Bodies used as instruments for God’s Glory (1 Cor. 6:19-20)

3. Build CHARACTER

- *Be Strong in the Lord* (Eph. 6)
 - Stand for truth
 - Resist the devil
 - Pray always
- *Overcome Trials and Temptations* (James 1, Romans 5)
